

# POOL FACT SHEET

## BLACKSPOT ALGAE

### BLACKSPOT ALGAE IN PEBBLECRETE (natural not coloured), TILED AND PLASTER POOLS (per 50,000 litres of water)

1. Remove pool cleaner from pool
2. Brush the walls and floors with a steel bristled brush or a stiff plastic brush for plaster pools. Black algae forms a membrane which needs to be broken for treatment to work
3. Add 1kg of Pure Blue Heavy Duty Blackspot Remover by sprinkling over the affected areas
4. Leave filtration off for 24 hours to allow treatment to attack blackspot.
5. It is recommend that 24 hours after adding the Blackspot Remover treatment that 1 litre Pure Blue Algae Control is added to the pool to kill any remaining algae spores that should remain
6. To prevent any spores reticulating into the filtration to vacuum to waste any debris on the floor of the pool.
7. At the completion of the treatment of your pool water, thoroughly clean your filter by using Filter Cleaner.

### BLACKSPOT ALGAE IN QUARTZON OR COLOURED PEBBLE POOLS (per 50,000 litres of water)

1. Superchlorinate all scrub and all affected areas
2. Add 1 litre Pure Blue B/Spot and algae Killer and leave filtration off for 24 hours
3. Vacuum to waste any debris on the floor of the pool
